RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS REGULAR SESSION & BUDGET HEARING

DECEMBER 12, 2016

The Board of Trustees for the Town of Flagler, Colorado met Monday December 12, 2016 for the REGULAR MEETING & BUDGET HEARING at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Municipal Building at 311 Main, Flagler Colorado. Trustees Tandi Moore, Harold Yutzy, Chuck Kinkel, Daymond Deatrich, Ivan Stahlecker, and Tami Witt were present. Employees present were Justin Crisp and Doris King. At 5:55 pm Mayor Thomas Bredehoft called the meeting to order followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVE MINUTES

Trustee Tandi Moore made the motion to approve the minutes from the November 14, 2016 regular meeting. Trustee Ivan Stahlecker seconded the motion. Motion passed and carried.

BUDGET HEARING

Mayor Tom Bredehoft called the budget hearing to order at 6:12 and asked for public comment, being no public comment after discussion the budget hearing was closed at 6:32 P.M.

OLD BUSINESS

- 1. Trustee Chuck Kinkel made the motion to cancel the current insurance policy with Rocky Mountain Health Plans and accept the proposal from Anthem for the Silver PPO plan. Trustee Tandi Moore seconded the motion. Motion passed and carried.
- 2. King and Crisp reported on the Bruno Animal Violations. King reported Bruno had registered and tagged seven dogs and would be rehomining the chickens. Crisp discussed the fines imposed by the municipal judge. King is to arrange a payment schedule with Bruno.
- 3. Crisp reported the new trash truck was ready and arrangements were being made to get the truck to Flagler.
- 4. King presented the bid from TJ's Flooring to repair the floors and replace the flooring. This was the only bid submitted. After discussion it was consensus of the council to accept TJ's Flooring bid and repair and replace the flooring damaged during the foundation stabilization as well as replace the carpet with tile in the remainder of the first floor of the hospital building. This is to be done with the grant funds. King will work on replacing some of the windows with the remainder of those funds.

- 1. King presented a letter from Colorado Municipal League explaining the Labor Act Changes for exempt employees. The current salary requirement is \$23,300.00 yearly and has been increased to \$47,476.00. This change went into effect December 01, 2016. After discussion Trustee Chuck Kinkel moved to table the discussion until the January 9th meeting to allow further review. Trustee Daymond Deatrich seconded the motion. Motion passed and carried.

- 5. Resolution TOF RES-107 Appropriate Funds 2017Budget: Trustee Daymond Deatrich motioned to accept, seconded by Trustee Harold Yutzy, motion passed and carried.
- 6. Resolution TOF RES-108 Expend Funds 2016 Budget: Trustee Ivan Stahlecker motioned to accept, seconded by Trustee Harold Yutzy, motion passed and carried.
