## RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS REGULAR SESSION

## **JANUARY 09, 2017**

The Board of Trustees for the Town of Flagler, Colorado met Monday January 09, 2017 for the REGULAR MEETING at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Municipal Building at 311 Main, Flagler Colorado. Trustees Tandi Moore, Chuck Kinkel, Daymond Deatrich and Ivan Stahlecker were present. Employees present were Justin Crisp, and Doris King. At 6:00 pm Mayor Thomas Bredehoft called the meeting to order followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### **APPROVE MINUTES**

Trustee Chuck Kinkel made the motion to approve the minutes from the December 12, 2016 regular meeting & Budget Hearing. Trustee Ivan Stahlecker seconded the motion. Motion passed and carried.

#### **PUBLIC AUDIENCE**

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

Justin Crisp reported he had been in contact with Cortxia regarding their application for the land.
 Crisp reported Cortxia representatives would be in Colorado January 13-19.

2. King reported the health plan with Rocky Mountain had been cancelled as of December 31,

2016 and the policy had begun with Anthem.

3. Crisp reported more complaints had been received regarding the dogs at 306 Julian. Several complaints of the dogs at large, cat killed by the dogs and damage to a vehicle. Crisp reported he had contacted the Town's attorney (Stan Kimble) and the municipal judge. Court is scheduled for Thursday, January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at 1:30 PM at Town Hall.

4. Crisp reported the new trash truck had been in use since delivery and was going well.

5. King reported the flooring for the first floor of the hospital building had been ordered through Superior Builders in Limon and would be delivered late January and installed by TJ's Flooring.

6. The exempt employee law was discussed but tabled because of this being undecided by court appeals and ligation.

7. At 6:25 PM Trustee Chuck Kinkel made the motion to enter executive session to discuss employee wage and salary rates with only the council and Mayor. Trustee Tandi Moore seconded the motion. Motion passed and carried. Doris King and Justin Crisp left the building at that time. At 6:45 Trustee Chuck Kinkel made the motion to exit executive session. Trustee Ivan Stahlecker seconded the motion. Motion passed and carried. Crisp and King returned to the meeting. Trustee Chuck Kinkel made the motion to increase employee wages Ryan Ashlock 10%, Timothy Johnson 3.9%, Melissa Thompson 4.8% employee salary increases Justin Crisp 3%, Terry Jaques 3% and Doris King 5% as of January 1, 2017. Trustee Daymond Deatrich seconded the motion. Motion passed and carried.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

1. Mayor Bredehoft and Justin Crisp reported they had met with a couple prior to the meeting regarding the free land incentive. They were interested in some land for a tree farm.

2. King reported Flagler Liquor Store was sending four employees to attend a state approved server training on January 19<sup>th</sup> to begin the process of liquor tasting events. King explained the town would have to set up guidelines for this and have an ordinance to provide regulations for liquor tasting permits. After discussion the council gave King direction on information for the ordinance and it will be reviewed at the next meeting.

#### **REPORTS**

#### MANAGER REPORT

1. Town Manager Justin Crisp reported the International Trash Truck was taken to Kois Brothers for sale. Crisp stated some repairs would have to be made before it could be sold.

2. Crisp reported that the recent snow storm on the 17<sup>th</sup> of December had gone well as far as snow removal.

#### TRASH DEPARTMENT

Crisp reported the Town of Seibert may be required to accept new bids on trash service.
 Discussion was held regarding restructuring the current pricing system now in place on the trash service and possibly rebidding on the Seibert Trash pickup.

2. Crisp reported dumpsters were being repaired each week.

- 3. Crisp reported the old Freightliner truck was being used as well as the new one for trash pickup.
- 4. Crisp reported new wheels and bottoms had been ordered to continue to repair dumpsters.

#### STREET DEPARTMENT

#### **WATER**

- Crisp reported a switch on the Briggs well had frozen and would have to be repaired at an estimated cost of \$700.00.
- 2. Crisp reported a valve at 2<sup>nd</sup> & Navajo would have to be replaced in the spring.
- 3. Crisp reported a fire hydrant at 5th & Navajo needed repair or replaced.
- 4. Crisp reported he had repaired a water break at 4<sup>th</sup> & Main on December 18<sup>th</sup>.
- 5. Crisp reported two new registers had been installed at the Briggs & Otteman well and the existing turbines would have to be rebuilt.
- 6. Crisp discussed the water tap on the property at the north end of Main Ave. At some point the line servicing the tap had been abandoned and there is not water service there at this time. The property is being sold and the buyer was under the impression the tap was live. The council agreed the new water tap would be the responsibility of the present owner or buyer.

#### PARKS AND RECREATION REPORT

- 1. Trustee Tandi Moore asked that the clerk put an ad in the newspaper for recreation director and concessions.
- 2. Crisp reported a large tree was cut down at the playground at the town park and ask if he should try to get it carved. It was agreed by the council to have the tree trunk carved. Crisp is to get an estimate on the cost.
- 3. Crisp reported two of the poles for the Christmas lights on Main Ave needed to be replaced. The council asked Crisp to get a cost estimate on this.

1. After reviewing the financial report, Trustee Chuck Kinkel made the motion to accept the financial report as presented. Trustee Ivan Stahlecker seconded the motion. Motion passed and carried.
