# RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS REGULAR SESSION

July 11, 2016

The Board of Trustees for the Town of Flagler, Colorado met Monday July 11, 2016 for the REGULAR MEETING at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Municipal Building at 311 Main, Flagler Colorado. Trustee Ivan Stahlecker, Tandi Moore, Chuck Kinkel, Tami Witt and Daymond Deatrich were present. Employees present were Justin Crisp and Doris King. At 5:56 pm Mayor Thomas Bredehoft called the meeting to order followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### **APPROVE MINUTES**

Trustee Chuck Kinkel made the motion to approve the minutes from the June 13, 2016 regular meeting. Trustee Ivan Stahlecker seconded the motion. Motion passed and carried.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

- Justin Crisp reported the water improvement project was near completion. Crisp stated a few minor projects were being completed by subcontractors.
- 2. King presented project expenditures as of June 30, 2016 to be filed for grant reimbursement. Total expenditures Habitat Construction \$391,939.87, GMS INC \$30,582.60 and Town of Flagler legal reimbursement \$10,700.00. Trustee Chuck Kinkel made the motion to approve for submittal the total expenditures. Trustee Ivan Stahlecker seconded the motion. Motion passed and carried.
- 3. King reported work on the hospital building foundation rehabilitation was in full swing. Helical piers were being placed as specified by the engineers and work was moving well within schedule.

# **NEW BUSINESS**

- 1. King presented a liquor license renewal application for Reliable Enterprise. Trustee Ivan Stahlecker made the motion to approve the renewal application for Reliable Enterprise. Trustee Tami Witt seconded the motion. Motion passed and carried.
- 2. King presented a request to move the antique lamp post north of the porch of the hospital building to the front of the theatre. The lamp is now covered in the blue spruce tree. After discussion Trustee Chuck Kinkel made the motion to relocate the lamp to the front of the theatre. Trustee Tandi Moore seconded the motion. Motion passed with Trustee Witt recusing from the vote.

## **REPORTS**

## MANAGER REPORT

- Town Manager Justin Crisp reported he had put Timothy Johnson in the trash truck for the time being.
- 2. Crisp reported with the three new wells being put online there would have to be access to the wells. Crisp request a road be built which will decrease the farmable ground by 1 to 1 ½ acres. The lesser would have to be paid for that loss as well as the area required by the water fill station.
- 3. Crisp reported the transmission had completely gone out of the Dodge bucket truck. Therefore Dodge would not buy back the truck. Crisp opinion was to repair the transmission and keep the truck at a cost of \$4,000.00 to \$5,000.00. Trustee Chuck Kinkel made the motion to repair the transmission at a cost of up to \$5,000.00. Trustee Tandi Moore seconded the motion. Motion passed with Trustee Witt recusing from the vote.
- 4. Community Wide Clean Up was discussed. Tabled until further details can be discussed.

# **TOWN CLERK**

- 1. King reported the current carrier for VSP vision insurance would be retiring August 30, 2016. King will bring further information to the August meeting.
- 2. King reported Habitat Construction had paid the homeowner for damage to sidewalk at 424 Kendall.
- King reported a construction meeting would be held July 20<sup>th</sup> at Town Hall regarding the Hospital Foundation Rehabilitation.
